HB0017, Raw milk.

Comments

Pretty much bans raw milk. More bureaucratic micromanagement and prohibition.

This bill moves from protecting rights to dictating the use of property and right to contract. We are not wards of the state unable to think for ourselves. This act restricts a person's right to purchase what s/he chooses. Extremely restrictive and cost prohibitive. The owner must, test, be registered, and report. A person, of his own volition cannot choose to purchase raw milk. This is a restriction of liberty. Warnings and information is required that a person already knows if s/he buys milk at a dairy (not a store). Why else would the person buy at a dairy, they want what the dairy has to offer.
