Comments

A revenue measure. This eliminates house trailers as a category for registration fees, and folds them into other trailers. Instead of a flat \$15, they will now be charged according to weight, up to \$60.

R+: Increases net revenue from state-level house trailer registration fees by about \$200,000. Increases revenue but does it in a manner that appears to be more fair than the current system.
