Comments

Two industries that government dominates either entirely or almost entirely: workers compensation "insurance" and education. And it does both badly. I can't see that this bill improves or damages anyone's liberty.

R+: LSO estimates that school districts would pay total additional premiums of \$2,284,379 to the Worker's Compensation Industrial Accident fund for FY 2015, FY 2016, and FY 2017. Workman's Compensation seems to be a government insurance program that works in spite of it being a government monopoly. We'll call this liberty neutral in spite of a few qualms caused by the juxtaposition of "government" and "monopoly."
