Comments

This was an excellent bill even before the Supreme Court delivered its decision in Powers v Wyoming. It simply rolls SF 104 (2013) back to status quo ante. No questions of constitutionality, no wrangling, no uncertainty. But the Powers that Be are determined to condemn the state, including the children, to more of the aftermath of SF 104.

U: The fiscal or personnel impact is not determinable. A bill undoing the work of SF 104 from the previous session and making the state code compliant with the decision of the Supreme Court invalidating SF 104. This bill was essentially unnecessary since the decision of the Supreme Court and the subsequent implementation of that decision by the lower court essentially accomplished the same thing as was the aim of this bill. The intent of the bill was commendable but due to its being unnecessary and wasting legislative time and energy, we'll call this one liberty neutral.
