U: This bill has administrative impact that appears to increase (or decrease) duties or responsibilities of one or more state agencies and may impact agency spending or staffing requirements. As introduced, the bill does not modify any state agency budget or current personnel authorizations. This bill lessens the power of the Governor over the State Board of Education and places that power in the hands of board members elected by the People. Governmental centralization is always inimical to Liberty and this lessens state governmental centralization.
