HB0125, Local option tax-municipalities.

Sponsors: Representative(s) Miller, Blake, Krone, Larsen and Piiparinen and Senator(s) Case and Coe

Comments

Creates a new mechanism for a local sales tax option, but in no case will local sales tax options exceed two percent of the price of the item being taxed. Since the total tax to be collected doesn't change, this is not a tax increase. So liberty neutral.

R+: The fiscal impact, in the form of potential revenue increases to cities and towns, is indeterminable. This bill enables some incorporated municipalities to charge an additional excise tax for specific projects providing that the voters approve the increase. From a Liberty viewpoint, tax increases are always problematic, but if it is approved by the People affected, we will give it a pass and with grumbles call it Liberty neutral.
