Sponsors: Representative(s) Gay, Davison, McKim and Watt and Senator(s) Meier

Comments

Adds a requirement that removal of the attorney general be with the advice and consent of the senate.

N: No fiscal or personnel impact. This bill attempts to insulate the office of the State Attorney General from the Governor by making it more difficult for the Governor to fire the Attorney General for disagreeing with him. Government decentralization is a good thing for Liberty so we will give this bill credit for taking a step in the right direction. What would have gained a Hallelujah chorus would have been a Constitutional amendment making the office of the Attorney General an elected office!
