Comments

Disallows community colleges and UW from requiring "remedial classes" except as part of a degree program. This does the students who do require remediation a great disservice. A very bad bill, if for no other reason than it continues to throw students under the busses of efficiency and testing.

U: The fiscal or personnel impact is not determinable. Basically, Wyoming high school graduates may not be required by UW or the community colleges to take remedial courses which are not directly creditable to a degree program. This implies that these schools may have been padding their remedial course requirements to enhance the revenue potential of enrolled students. Seen in this light, we'll call this one Liberty enhancing.
