Comments

Specifies that Wyoming accepts the boundary of the Wind River Reservation as that established in 1868 and as subsequently amended. This is a shot across the bow of the EPA.

U: The fiscal or personnel impact is not determinable. This bill appears to honestly define the boundaries of the Wind River Indian Reservation based on United States treaties and amendments thereto. As such, it is a valid vehicle to precipitate legal action over issues relative to those boundaries which shows that the State of Wyoming is willing to stand up for its rights under the Constitution of the United States.
